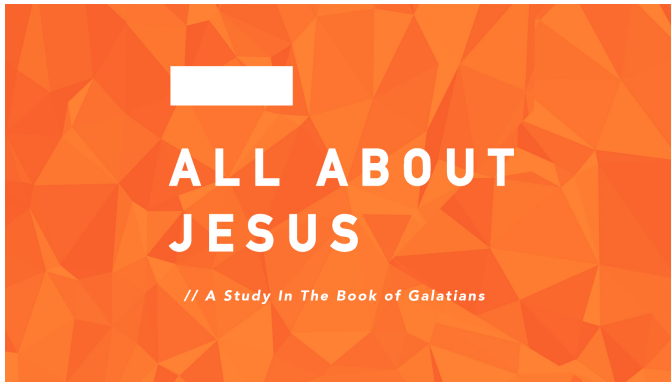


All About Jesus 2 - Foundations

Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

"I am shocked over how quickly you have deserted the grace gospel and strayed away from Christ who called you to Himself by His loving mercy. I'm frankly astounded that you now embrace a distorted gospel of salvation by works. That is a fake "gospel" that is simply not true. There is only one gospel – the grace gospel! You have allowed those who mingle law with Christ's grace to confuse you with lies." Galatians 1:6-7 Passion

Read Galatians 1:10, Ephesians 2:8-10, I Cor 3:10-11, Galatians 1:10-2:21, John 1:14 (overview)

1. What stood out to you about Sunday's message? Why?
2. We are not saved *by* good works, but *for* good works. What is the difference? Discuss this statement.
3. The "gospel" of works attempts to get us to be impressed with ourselves. The gospel of grace causes us to be totally impressed with Jesus. Why is this the case?
4. In Galatians 1:10, Paul asked, "Do I seek to please people?" What happens when we seek to please others as our life's priority?
5. There are three options in life: living to please yourself, living to please others, and living to please the Lord. What is the difference between them? What are the outcomes of choosing each?
6. Jesus is full of grace and truth. Therefore, grace and truth are in the foundation of Christ in our lives. Discuss what happens when we attempt to have one without the other - either grace without truth, or truth without grace.
7. Why was it necessary for Paul to publically address Peter's actions in the Antioch church?
