
## All About Jesus 4 – Sons, Citizens, Heirs

Week of 10.2.16 | Talk It Over Discussion Guide

These discussion points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you take the next step. If you're leading a group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

## Read Galatians 3:26-28, 4:6-7, Psalm 87:5-6, Philippians 3:20

- 1. Galatians 3:26 says "You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus." What does it mean to be a son? Discuss what was written on your "new birth certificate".
- 2. Your new birth makes you a supernatural-born citizen of God's Kingdom. What does it mean to be a citizen of God's kingdom? How do we withstand challenges to our citizenship?
- 3. What do these statements/declarations mean to you:
  - a. In God's family, there are no second-born sons.
  - b. In God's Kingdom, there are no second-class citizens.
  - c. In God's economy, there is no one beneath the poverty line.
- 4. What does it mean to belong? What does belonging feel like to you? What does it feel like to not belong to you?
- 5. In Galatians 3:28 we learn that Christ is now our primary identity. The message discussed no other adjectives coming before the word "Christian", either considered positive or negative. What does this mean? How have you done this?
- 6. Discuss this statement based on Galatians 3:28: None of these distinctions qualify for you a greater status in God's kingdom, because nothing can qualify you anymore than the cross of Jesus has already qualified you.
- 7. Because you are sons, you are no longer slaves, but free. What does this mean? How does it make a difference in our everyday lives?
